School Ski PE is available any day Snowbowl is open and that the public schools are open.

If your group needs transportation, bus service is available through Snowbowl's bus provider, Hellgate Transportation. You can contact them directly (549-0594) or we can help make arrangements and incorporate the transportation into the package price.

There is a minimum of eight students in order to participate in the Ski P.E. Program. Teachers are given one free lift ticket for every 10 participating students. Having parents at Snowbowl to chaperone students during their lessons (riding the lift with students, helping students with rental equipment, etc) is a big help and we are happy to extend to these parent chaperones special all day chaperone lift tickets at a discounted price. Kindergarten and First Grade students are at an especially perfect time for learning but they do require extra attention. The program price is slightly higher for these younger skiers so we can provide smaller class sizes to give them that extra attention. Programs for students under 5 years old are possible with special arrangement-please give us a call.

Additionally, we realize that not everyone can afford to go skiing all the time so we do offer a scholarship program, please call the ski school for details.

Several weeks before your school date, we will send you the rental-registration cards. These should be returned to us in advance of your date (preferably two weeks prior but no less than a week) so we can get as much of the classes and equipment set up and ready to ensure a smooth Ski P.E. day for your students.
